We at the Elliot Hospital are saddened by your pregnancy loss and understand that this may be a difficult time for you. We are, however, aware that the feelings you have

about your loss are unique to you and your individual circumstance.

While some people may not feel the need to make specific final arrangements for their pregnancy loss, many have found some comfort in being able to memorialize their loss in some way. In lieu of private arrangements, remains will be placed in the Elliot Hospital Memory Garden.

The Memory Garden is an appointed space on Elliot Hospital grounds, which has

been created as a memorial for pregnancy loss. At its center stands the Angel of Hope statue. The Angel designates a special place where you can go to reflect on your loss and find hope during your grief journey.

In choosing this option, you need do nothing further. The hospital will arrange for

cremation with a licensed funeral home at no cost to you. All ashes from the previous year are stored collectively by the funeral home. With this option, there are no individual ashes.

The ashes will be placed in the Memory Garden at the base of the Angel of Hope during an annual ceremony on the Sunday of Memorial Day weekend at 1:00pm (rain or shine). You, your family and your friends are welcome to attend the service.

The Memory Garden is located on a small hill opposite the hospital's main entrance. You are invited to visit the garden at any time.
